

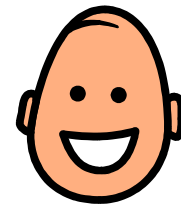


Safeguarding

- We think it is important for everyone to know where to get help if they are worried or unhappy about something.

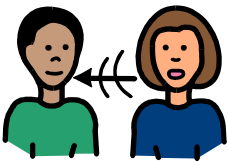

- Mrs Pearsall or Alma



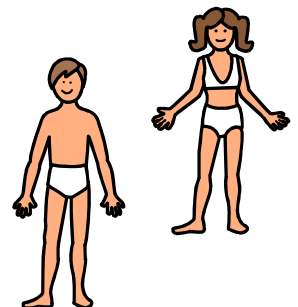
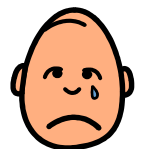

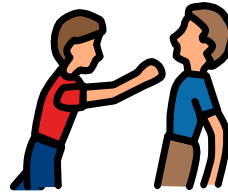
- Bullying you
